OVERSEAS TRAVEL HAS RESUMED


Thanks to all of those who have continued with support for the LBT ministry we do in Tanzania. In April, Michael was able to visit three areas in Tanzania. The South East of Lake Victoria Diocese has invited LBT to partner with them in outreach to the Datooga people. There are approximately 586,000 Datooga, and less than 1% have accepted Christ. Pray for guidance in moving forward with the request.



Michael also visited the ongoing Kerewe program on Ukerewe Island, Tanzania. They have finished drafting Jonah, Luke and Acts. It is our prayer to visit again in August to finalize their translation and do the typesetting so that the three books can be published and distributed. Then they will begin translating Matthew, Mark, John and the Pentateuch (Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers and Deuteronomy). (Picture: Michael teaching the Kerewe translators.)

MORE TANZANIA TRIP

During the trip, the Regional Directors for East and Southern Africa (LBT) joined up with Michael, and they had a wonderful visit with staff from the Bible Society of Tanzania, discussing areas of possible partnership. In the picture, starting with Michael on the left: Dr. A. Kimonge (General Secretary BST), Sarah Esala (incoming Regional Director, LBT), Rev. I. Mwangota (BST), and Jim Laesch (Regional Director, LBT). Seated is Rev. O. Lema, Assistant Bishop of East of Lake Victoria Diocese and Program Manager of the Kerewe Bible Translation Program. (Rev. Lema stands 6'8.5" so he had to sit to be in the frame.) Rev. Mwangota helps with the computer program used by the translators. He trains the translators, helps them when they encounter problems, and helps in the typesetting when products are ready for publication. It is always a blessing to be in partnership with Bible societies throughout the world.
