The **Liberia Translation and Literacy Organization** (LIBTRALO) was established in 1995. Their mission: help the people of Liberia be proud of their languages and use them to enhance their faith, life, and culture. LIBTRALO supports Bible translation, literacy, Scripture use, and multilingual education programs for 15 language communities.

LIBTRALO employs skilled staff to administer, maintain, and promote the programs under its jurisdiction. From the translation director to the finance and PR officers, IT personnel to the maintenance attendant, all believe that a people's language, culture and faith are crucial for growth and development.

As a not-for-profit organization, LIBTRALO relies on support from donors to fund salaries, training, equipment, vehicle operation and travel expenses. While fundraising and awareness events raise some support within Liberia, additional gifts will assure financial stability. A fully funded LIBTRALO can continue to offer uninterrupted assistance that benefits language communities throughout the country.
