Until the completion of the Komba New Testament in 2014, the Komba people of northern Ghana were greatly influenced by traditional religious beliefs. Since then, the New Testament has reached families, churches and communities through written and audio formats as well as a Scripture app.

But the New Testament is only part of the story. Church leaders look forward to the day when the Old Testament will be available. Then the Komba will fully understand the scope of God's plan, from Creation to the fulfillment of the Messianic prophecies.
