began in early 2010 as a grassroots movement of the Nsenga-speaking people in Zambia. On July 14, 2016, the Nsenga people of Zambia received the first ever published version of God's Word in their own language. Prior to this, Nsenga people could only hear the Gospel through a foreign language. God was, for many, just as foreign as the language the missionaries brought with them.

Translation work continued, completely under the Bible Society, with work on the Old Testament. And now, Lutheran Bible Translators has eagerly jumped on board to be a part of this life-changing project – to put God's Word in their hands!
