Missions have always interested me, but I never thought I would actually feel called to work in the mission field full time until my Junior year. I took my time officially answering that call. After my internship with LBT post-graduation, it was almost a full year later when I finally requested the job application from the organization.

Following God's call, however sure of it that you may be, can still be terrifying. I put a lot of pressure on myself, asking questions like: "What if I don't raise the money?" and "What if I constantly fail at my job?" ... My insecurities about becoming a missionary clearly lie in what I believe about *myself* and *my own* capabilities. What I should believe in instead are the capabilities of the One who sent me: Jesus. It is HE who began this good work in me, as Paul also reminds the Philippians, and it is HE who will continue it until it is finished.

I hope and pray that you - just like I have had to learn how to do over the last few months - remember to give all of your trust and insecurities to Jesus. He who began this good work in you will not leave you out to dry - He will see it through for His sake. Praise God that it has never, and will not ever be dependent on us to keep His mission going!



WHERE WILL I BE GOING?

As of right now, I am preparing to be a translation advisor to Bible translation programs in Africa!

LBT regional directors are in the process of discussing options for my placement in either an existing project or a new Bible translation project. I will stay busy these next few months speaking at churches about Bible translation and my new role, and this Fall I will be studying Applied Language and Translation at a college in the UK for six months.

For now, I am enjoying time in Iowa with family and working from home. It has already been quite the adventure learning the ropes of work in ministry. I'm thankful for your support during this journey!
