TRAINING NEW PEOPLE

Part of our work involves training new people in order to expand the work of Bible translation and Scripture Engagement. Training is done in a variety of ways. Chuck teaches part time in the Linguistics and Bible Translation Department at the Theological College of Northern Nigeria. This training is designed to lead to a formal university degree. We also do informal training in a number of settings, from working with individuals or translation teams to mentoring people.

MULTIPLYING MENTORING

A colleague is doing doctoral work in an effort to train people more quickly and efficiently. It is often difficult to arrange for consultants-in-training to have supervised checking sessions with translation teams. For this project, several consultants will work with groups of three people in training and translation teams. What this means is that Chuck will get to know the three people in his group well over the next year in hopes to encourage them to grow together towards becoming consultants.


