Plans are underway to run a reprint.

Meanwhile, local chiefs and church leaders are encouraging people to read and engage with the Gospel. Work continues on Luke, John and Acts. A third translator will be added to the team so that Scripture will continue to reach this people so eager to have God's Word in their language.
