Thank you for your support of Subula translation and literacy. Significant progress has been made on translation of each of the Gospels. Ongoing training will enhance the team's knowledge of language construction and translation principles.

The much-in-demand Subula literacy classes began this February. Two local schools are also teaching mother tongue language classes.

Enthusiasm continues to grow among the Subula community as the project impacts their lives. A revised songbook, alphabet chart and orthography book have been warmly received. Proclaimers (compact, solar-powered devices that play the 1975 version of the Subula New Testament) will be distributed to over ten Listening Groups. Proclaimers will also be distributed to people who speak northern dialects of Subula. Most of these speakers are not Christian.

Planning continues for the construction of a Subula Language Center.
