We are reminded so often of the importance of reading and hearing God's Word in a language we can understand as we hear from LBT missionaries throughout the world. A recent newsletter from Jim Kaiser in Ethiopia caught our attention. Jim is a consultant who works with several translation projects and the local translators. He shared this story:

In one project area, younger children read Scripture to elders (who are not able to read). This builds community ties, gives the children practice in their new literacy skills, and brings the Word of God to the older generation who has never heard it in their language before. The translators shared a story of one woman who became a Christian after hearing a child read the story of the Prodigal Son to her.

We often don't even think about the luxury of having the Bible in our own language, and even having many different versions of it available. If you'd like to hear Scripture in a new way, try listening to it being sung!
