## "Groundbreaking" Work

Shortly after we arrived in Ethiopia last August, a devastating flood swept through the campus where we live. Several people were killed, including children who could not escape from their houses in time. Our house was spared, but many were not, leaving campus workers and their families without homes.

In cooperation with other organizations, Lutheran Bible Translators has helped to raise money to build a new ten-story mixed-use (commercial and residential) building. The bottom floors will be rented for income generation, and the top floors will provide safe, convenient, flood-proof housing for campus families. ### **Language Learning Update**

We are still spending a majority of our time in Amharic language school. We have "graduated" to the stage where we are reading fairy tales (like Goldilocks and Cinderella) in Amharic and answering written questions. (The Amharic script makes this a little bit hard!) We are also reading selections from a children's Bible story book. And of course there is plenty of conversation practice — with our teachers, but also with taxi drivers, shopkeepers, neighbors, and pretty much everyone else who wants us to hurry up and learn to speak their language!

We feel like we're still a long way from where we want to be — able to discuss the nuances of Bible translation in Amharic with teams in the field — but we're definitely improving and steadily on our way to being able to negotiate daily life in Ethiopia in our new host language!

#### **Bible Translation Conference**

Translation teams from around the country gathered in Addis recently to receive training, do strategic planning, and encourage one another with stories and progress reports from their various projects. Three new OT books on audio SD cards were dedicated by one team, and Chris gave a short presentation.
