Subula* Bible Translation & Literacy Project

Thank you for your prayers and support. The Subula people are rebuilding pride in their culture. Several communities have devoted themselves to speaking only their mother tongue.

Literacy class attendees are testing the instruction materials that will be used in future classes. A big part of literacy development is having a dictionary. Two literacy workers and two translators received training in lexicography - the process of writing, editing, and compiling dictionaries. These workers are now collecting data and hope to produce two dictionaries by the end of the year!

The Proclaimers (compact, solar-powered devices that play the 1975 version of the Subula New Testament) were distributed to 24 hearing groups, totaling 652 participants. Many hearers repented and several of them became Christians. Five new hearing groups have been created in other areas!
