Literacy & Scripture Engagement

Thanks be to God; the Mende Literacy and Scripture Engagement project is gaining momentum! The seven new literacy classes begun earlier this year continue to meet regularly. Fourteen students trained on pre-primer, seventeen on primer two, and fifteen on primer three! Primer levels are how literacy programs track progress. A pre-primer level is comparable to a US Kindergarten reading level.

Most Mende speakers in the Kowama community are Muslim, but literacy and Scripture engagement programs are changing the demographic. Faith Comes by Hearing, a partner organization, provides opportunities for community members to interact with audio Scripture in their heart language. A sixteen-year-old boy has come to faith through the Faith Comes by Hearing program in the Kowama community of the Gbagbe Chiefdom! Your gifts and prayers are moving mountains!
