## **GETTING BACK IN THE AIR**

Training for Nathan started slowly. He had not flown in a while and the folks at JAARS wanted him to review some of the basics. Much of his first few weeks were spent studying the standard operating procedures for JAARS and reading manuals for the planes he will be flying. Early on he was able to get some experience flying in the JAARS flight simulator.

Being at JAARS gives Nathan the special opportunity of working with his father, Jonathan, who spent 23 years as a missionary pilot in Papua New Guinea. Nathan's father was able to supervise his simulator flying. He also worked with Nathan to refamiliarize himself with the cockpit and procedures of flying. These were helpful for Nathan to regain comfort with flying, but he was itching to get back into the air.

Lastly, before flying again, Nathan had to complete "ground school." This involved having "class" with the JAARS training coordinator to learn the procedures that JAARS has for operation of their airplanes.

Thankfully, soon enough Nathan was able to fly again! On October 5<sup>th</sup>, Nathan had the opportunity to fly a JAARS Cessna 206 up to Raleigh and back. He was mentored by one of the JAARS aviation staff who has several years of experience flying in Brazil. Nathan was eager to get back behind the controls and this flight was a great encouragement to him! What a blessing it was to see him back in the air! His next flight was even more exciting! Nathan was able to fly with his dad for the first time since Nathan started his flight training! This was a flight for him to get used to how the Cessna 206 handles.
