We have upgraded the power situation at our house! We installed 8 solar panels on the roof and they run the majority of the electrical at our home now. The power here is getting more expensive and less reliable. so we wanted to try and get ahead of possible problems. We are still chasing a few issues related to the new system. but we are excited to be a bit more independent from the grid!



We have made a decision about MaryJane's education for high school! She wants to try going to school in America, so she will be living with Kelsey's brother in Denver and attending high school there. Please pray for all of us as we get ready for a BIG adjustment to our family dynamic and for MJ as she transitions to this new environment. We are a mixture of excited and scared for this new chapter in our lives.



Believe it or not, our 1999 Land Cruiser "Shrek" is on its last legs at more than 200,000 miles driven on rough Botswana roads. This vehicle has served us well, but the repair costs on a 24 year old vehicle are mounting, so we are going to look for a more reliable replacement vehicle. Pray that God would provide a vehicle that will meet our family's needs and our needs for work related travel.

Unfortunately, this was not a budgeted expense for this year. We are looking to raise around \$10,000 towards the purchase of a new (to us) vehicle.
