At the end of June, we completed the proofreading and typesetting process for the Shekgalagari New Testament. This involved a lot of careful checking and re-checking of the manuscript by specially hired proofreaders who had not interacted with the text before. We have now sent the completed manuscript on to the printer so that the New Testaments can be printed and shipped to us here in Botswana. That is a long and arduous journey, so please pray that our printed Bibles will be here on time for our scheduled launch on **November 25, 2023!** 



### Southern Africa Bible Translation Summit 2023

At the end of 2022, the need to have a gathering of different Bible translation organizations in the Southern Africa region was identified to help cooperation among the organizations, especially on cross-border projects. To that end, we wrote and received a grant to facilitate that gathering and on June 18-21, 2023, we gathered in Gaborone for the first ever Southern Africa Bible Translation Summit.

38 representatives from 18 Bible translation organizations that are active in 8 different countries were present at the summit and were able to join together in discussions and sharing about our shared goal of Bible translation. It was an amazing blessing to have so many people gathered together for this summit. We were able to share about our work in different countries, coordinate on some possible shared projects, network together, explore some training options and spend time meeting, talking and encouraging each other.

This summit was a lot of work for Carl, doing all the planning and organizing on his own. But the payoff has been already realized in new partner connections and shared information. A newly formed planning committee is already working on a plan for the next summit in the region and we are looking forward to it!

#### Botswana Sign Language Bible Translation Project officially launched in June 2023



The official launch of the Botswana Sign Language Bible Translation Project took place on June 15, 2023, here in Maun. There were many representatives of churches, government ministers, international supporters and deaf people in attendance. The celebration was a wonderful event and very encouraging to the sign language team. They were able to share some of their first completed translations with the group and a group of local deaf students shared some of their dancing skills. We are excited to see where God takes this project in the future!
