### Sierra Leone Trip

After more than fifteen years, I travelled back to Sierra Leone January 23 – February 5. It was good to see some old friends, and to make some new ones. Many things had changed since my last visit, but I was surprised at how many things were still the same.

I was part of a team of three consultants from Lutheran Bible Translators who travelled to Sierra Leone to work with projects there. Dr. Tim Beckendorf and Dr. Becky Grossmann came to work with the Themne Old Testament translation project, and I came to work with the Mende Old Testament translation project. During our first few days, we met with the leadership of the Bible Society of Sierra Leone (BSSL) and the United Bible Societies' consultant, Dr. Brigitte Rabarijaona. We discussed the projects and how we might best help. Then we separated and travelled to work with our individual teams.

We worked on the team's translation of 2 Samuel, and were able to finish the first twenty chapters.
