The Prayer Letter of Glenn & Susan Fluegge

## WHO ARE WE?

It was twenty-six years ago today – Jan 7, 1999. I remember the day quite vividly. We landed in Togo, West Africa, with two cranky kids and ten seventy-pound bags of personal belongings. Sleep-deprived and culturally disoriented, we stumbled through those first few weeks.

But we ended up staying eleven years in northern Togo as LCMS missionaries. During that time, I worked with the Centre Luthérien d'Etudes Théologiques, an international Lutheran seminary. We then spent three years in South Africa where I taught at a Lutheran seminary there.



In 2012, we transitioned back to the States to Concordia University Irvine in southern California. I've been serving as a theology professor and director of a seminary program at Concordia for the last thirteen years. Susan serves as administrative assistant to the school of arts and sciences.

Our work at Concordia has been quite fulfilling and living in southern California next to family has been refreshing. But I always wondered if God would someday call us back to Africa....

## **BACK TO AFRICA**

...Well, it seems He has. And in a way neither of us anticipated. A few months ago, Lutheran Bible Translators and Concordia University Irvine formed a partnership.





According to this unique partnership, I will be a theology professor at Concordia *AND* also a missionary with Lutheran Bible Translators. As a missionary, I'll serve as Seminary Program Coordinator. My job is to help Lutheran Bible Translators collaborate with partner seminaries and institutions worldwide to train up local Bible translators.



A year from now we move to Ethiopia!

Since Lutheran Bible Translators already has a thriving partnership with the Mekane Yesus Seminary (MYS) in Ethiopia, each year Susan and I will spend half of the year in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia. I will teach classes at the seminary and foster our ongoing partnership. Susan will continue her role online as administrative assistant at Concordia.

So, God is calling us back to Africa, but in a different way, with a different organization, and to a different part of Africa. We plan to move to Addis Ababa a year from now in January of 2026.

#### WHY ETHIOPIA?

The Ethiopian Evangelical Church Mekane Yesus, the world's largest Lutheran church, is facing a challenge: *Over half of Ethiopia's 85 languages lack Bible translations.* 

To help meet this challenge, Mekane Yesus Seminary recently partnered with Lutheran Bible Translators to launch a unique Bible translation Bachelor of Theology (BTh) program. This initiative aims to equip future local pastors and church leaders to translate the Bible into the multitude of languages throughout Ethiopia.

The program's first cohort is currently about half way through their studies and will graduate soon. They will then return to their home churches scattered throughout Ethiopia where many of them will be involved in Bible translation and Scripture engagement projects.

The vision shared by both organizations is ambitious, planning for multiple graduating cohorts. This would mean an increase in Bible translators, significantly expanding access to Scripture in native languages for millions.
