The idiom "light a fire under" is commonly used in English to express the urgency or importance of a task. It means to motivate someone or something into action, often with a sense of urgency

I was trying to think of a way to describe how the work of the Evangelical Lutheran Church (ELC) in Papua New Guinea impacts the Gospel for their country, because it is HUGE! "Light a fire" absolutely came to mind. Already, since we were there in February to do a workshop with the leaders of the institutions, the ELC has set up a Translation Committee, and is prayerfully looking for the first Translation and Mission Coordinator to head up Bible Translation for the denomination.



Nehemiah 9:12

By day you led them with a pillar of cloud, and by night with a pillar of **fire** to give them **light** on the way they were to take.

"We have to be prepared because once the word goes out that the ELC has a Bible Translation office, the requests are going to pour in by people who want help getting translations started in their language, and we are quickly going to be overwhelmed".





Back to PNG we go for a second workshop in September to meet with those on the district level, and various Bible Translation Agencies working within PNG. We will work together to see where the holes are, and what still needs to be done. 800 languages. 500 don't have a single verse translated.

Sunday School is a hot topic for the Waria River Area this year. The church has requested that the translators now find time to help translate Sunday School materials into the local languages. This means translators will have to pause their Bible Translation or commit extra time. Everyone is happy to help!
