

LEVITICUS & CREATION COMIC FOR THE KEREWEE*

I got a WhatsApp message from the Kerewe team saying that they planned to distribute 200 copies of Leviticus for adults and 100 copies of the creation story in comic form for children at a village. They said they are focusing on touching the lives of children and creating interest in reading the Kerewe Bible. After the event, I've heard that even adults are "running" to the comic booklets. What a joy!

Since 2022, I have been supporting the Kerewe translation team in Tanzania to be more self-organized and equipped for higher-quality translation in the early stages. We have also increased the team's collaboration with the broader Kerewe community through early and incremental distribution of Scripture as portions are completed! They are having fun distributing God's Word in a new location around the island about once a month.

*Kikerewe is spoken by around 400,000 people on Ukerewe Island on Lake Victoria on the northwestern border of Tanzania. **Books completed:** Genesis, Leviticus, Ruth, Jonah, the Gospels, Acts, Jude. **In Progress:** Exodus, Numbers. **Up Next:** Deuteronomy. The full Bible is 24% completed!

WHAT'S NEXT?

I hit the ground running in 2026 with a new budget and set of goals. My responsibilities are similar to last year, but my supervisors increased the time dedicated to research and experimentation of emerging methods for Bible translation. I plan to take a few international trips and support translation efforts remotely through training and checking. For 2026, I plan on...

- Working in translation development and training, including developing resources that can be used by others to train translators remotely and to support efforts of self-organization and community engagement.
- Training as a Translation Consultant by studying, learning through shadowing, and doing supervised checking of translations.
- Reading, researching, and writing for my Doctorate of Ministry in Bible Translation (a requirement to become certified as a consultant).
- Research and test emerging methods and tools, particularly if and how AI might be leveraged to improve translation quality.
