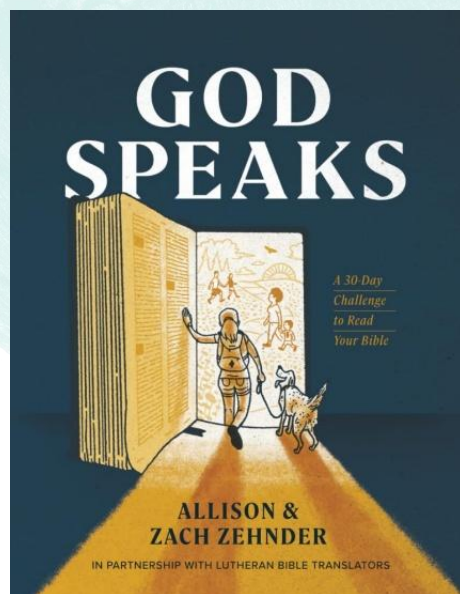




PARTNER RESOURCES

Prayer calendar:

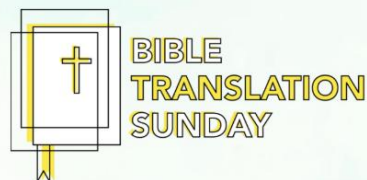

TRANSLATION TIDBIT

When the Themne team and I came to “covenant of salt” in Numbers 18:19, I stopped to ask them what that meant to them. They immediately answered that it was a very binding covenant that was to be forever. They went on to describe how they rub salt on meat to indicate that an oath being taken is binding. Their custom is very similar to this Hebrew practice.
